

Emergency Plan

HAZARDOUS SPILL/LEAK

If a hazardous spill, flammable liquid spill or gas leak occurs, the following procedure must be carried out:

Note: Assembly areas and the routes to them will be subject to wind direction.

PERSON WHO DISCOVERS SPILL/LEAK

- Warns and removes anyone in immediate danger.
- Notifies Chief Warden
- If safe, protected and trained, contains spill/leak. If not, evacuates area.



CHIEF WARDEN

- Ensures Emergency Services are called, if required.
- Alerts neighbouring, if advised.
- Co-ordinates emergency actions
- Provides liaison with Emergency Services and neighbours.
- Notify Group Environment Manager



WARDENS

- Evacuates area if required, or if instructed by the Chief Warden.
- Accounts for personnel
- Acts as requested by the Chief Warden



Group Environment Manager

• To notify the following authorities as per the POEO Act, 2011

Notification Procedure

- Incident Identified and reported to Management
- Chief Warden / Site Manager directs response
- Chief Warden / Site Manager reports to relevant emergency services if required
- Neighbours are alerted if required
- GEM & Directors notified
- Report to relevant Authorities as required.
